SEPA Threshold Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) FILE - SEPA15-010 / WATV's Ord.

Date: June 29, 2015

To: Washington State Agencies, Tribes, local governmental agencies and community groups

Pursuant to Washington State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), the City of Dayton is issuing this Notice of SEPA Threshold Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS).

Description of Proposal: Proposed Ordinance 1881 of the City of Dayton, WA, allowing licensed drivers to operate wheeled all-terrain vehicles on city streets with a speed limit of 35 miles per hour or less by enacting DMC Chapter 7-6.

Proponent & Lead agency: City of Dayton


